

# ARE YOU REGISTERED FOR YOUR COVID-19 VACCINE?

Because different vaccination sites are run by different systems, you should register for more than one.

## Saint Louis County Department of Public Health

To be vaccinated by the Saint Louis County DPH:

- Visit **stlcorona.com** and click on **"COVID-19 Vaccine Pre-Registration."**
- If you don't have internet access, call 314-615-2660 to register.

## State of Missouri mass vaccination sites

To register for these events:

- Visit **covidvaccine.mo.gov** and select **"Register"** from the top of the page
- Those without internet access can call 877-435-8411.

## Hospitals and pharmacies

Hospitals and pharmacies may also have supplies of the vaccine. Check with the location closest to you to find out how to register.

## What should I know before I get my shot?

These vaccines have been approved by the FDA because they are safe and effective. You CANNOT get COVID-19 from a vaccine. You may feel sore or get a headache or chills after your appointment, but this is just a sign that your body is building an immune response.

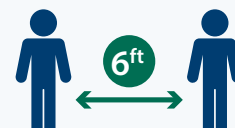
